Editors - Terms of Reference

Composition

One editor for each publication (*Canadian Field-Naturalist_and Trail & Landscape*) and special publication appointed by the Board on the recommendation of the Publications Committee. Editors may appoint assistant editors as required, with approval of the Board of Directors.

Mandate

- 1. To ensure that the content of the publication is consistent with the established editorial policy.
- 2. To produce the publication and ensure that the publication schedule is met.
- 3. To keep the Publications Committee informed of any issue arising in regards to the publication.

Duties

- 1. Identifying when associate editor(s) are needed.
- 2. Recommending the appointment of associate editor(s) to the Publications Committee.
- 3. Identifying when assistant editor(s) are needed.
- 4. Recommending the appointment of assistant editor(s) to the Publications Committee.
- 5. Meeting occasionally with the Board as required, to keep the Board informed on the progress of the publication.
- 6. Sending a copy of all editorials to the President and the Publications Committee prior to publication.
- 7. Recommending editorial policy changes to the Publications Committee.
- 8. The editor of *Trail & Landscape* will keep records of costs and prepare an annual budget, as no business manager is currently appointed. (Publications Committee meeting, 30 October 1992).
