OFNC Publications Committee - Terms of Reference

Composition

The Committee must include the Editor and Journal Manager of *The Canadian Field-Naturalist*, the Editor of *Trail & Landscape*, the editors of other publications, and three or more members not associated with the publications.

Editors of special publications are ex-officio members of the committee for the duration of their editorial appointment.

Mandate

- 1. To advise the Board of Directors in all matters pertaining to the publications of the club.
- 2. To review the Publications Policy periodically, and, if required, recommend changes to the Board of Directors.
- 3. To recommend an editor for each publication, as required, for appointment by the Board of Directors.
- 4. In consultation with the editor, appoint associate editors for each publication, as required.
- 5. To supervise the policy, finances and distribution of the club's publications.

Duties

- 1. Ensuring that the club Publication Policy is adhered to.
- 2. Maintaining awareness of the policies, status, staffing, finances, and distribution of the club's publications through reports and forecasts from the editors and Journal Manager.
- 3. Ensuring that the club's publications are oriented to meeting the objectives of the club.
- Acting as a liaison between the Board of Directors and the editors and maintaining a constructive dialogue with the editors on matters of policy, operations, and procedures.
- 5. Resolving concerns of the editors or members of the club respecting the publications.

- 6. Recommending an editor for each special publication to the Board of Directors.
- 7. Preparing grant applications to funding agencies, as required.
- 8. Recommending to the Board of Directors changes in the honoraria paid to publications editors and the Journal Manager.

Note 1:

Extract from the Minutes of the Council [now Board of Directors] dated February 9, 1987:

"moved (R. Bedford, 2nd J. Reddoch) at Council on 9 February that all matters concerning publications and all directives to journal editors be referred to the Publications Committee for consideration before Council takes action, Motion carried; one abstention!"
