## **Spring version**

Trail 51 has a series of loops depending on how far you want to walk and how much time you have. Loop A-B-C-A takes you near a bridge (between C-D) that crosses a stream near a beaver dam and lodge. Loop D-E-F-D, called the Nut Tree Trail, has information about three oak species and white pines. You might also travel the road between the hydro lines where you might find butterflies, birds, wildflowers, and frogs.
