

Visual and Sound Wildlife Quests for Richmond Conservation Area

Richmond Conservation Area was once known as the Richmond Sewage Lagoons. Be aware there is another area (★ on map) with the same name. The area has elevated trails around three former sewage lagoons that have varying degrees of water. Many shorebirds and ducks are present and when there is water a number of Painted Turtles may be present. There are no facilities.

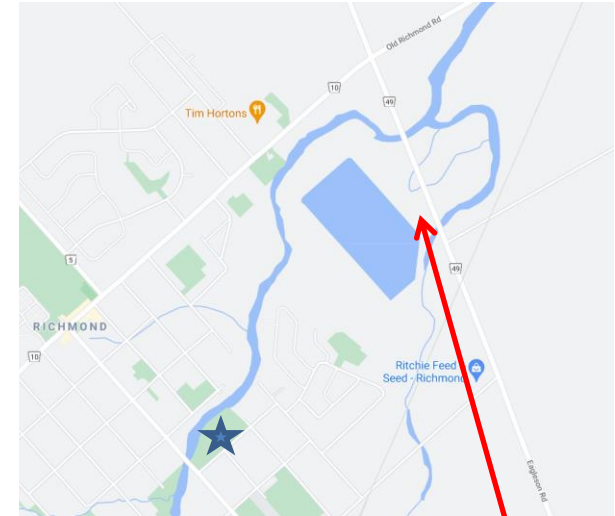
