

Visual and Sound Wildlife Quests for Pinhey Sand Dunes and Forest

Pinhey Sand Dunes is a small part of **Pinhey Forest**. It is notable for having several rare insects and spiders that are not found anywhere else in Ottawa. Note that some of the dunes are restricted entry to protect the dunes.

Note also that there is Poison Ivy along the forest trails. There is no danger as long as you don't touch the plants.
